2. Business challenge solved
3. Why you chose AnyLogic
4. Why your work is significant
 - a) Benefit achieved (Tangible numbers or evidence recommended)
5. Show AnyLogic model (Through recording; we are happy to assist you in recording your model)
6. Q & A
